**HIGHLIGHTS:** Areas of fog/low clouds this AM, otherwise sunny & a little cooler today. Near normal temps tomorrow & Wed, then warming up later this week... possibly **hot** over the weekend. *Major* cool down by the middle of next week.

Short Term Weather Discussion: A compact upper level low, that was over Central OR yesterday, is dropping down over NV this morning cooling the air mass aloft over CA to some degree. Meanwhile, the marine layer has deepened from about 1000ft to 1500ft in the past 24 hours and marine stratus (low clouds/fog) returned to the North Coast's valleys this morning. Both of these factors suggest some cooling today with highs likely topping off near normal (mainly upper 70s to upper 80s) after a warmer than normal weekend & last Friday. No major changes are expected tomorrow and/or Wednesday as a weak residual trough hangs over California in the wake of the cutoff low slowly exiting eastward across Utah & then the Rockies. Models do indicate a bit more of a northerly gradient down the coast. It remains to be seen whether the northerlies down the coast are strong enough to keep the late night and early morning marine stratus from moving inland. Believe it will keep the stratus out of Napa County, but probably not Sonoma. Models vary whether we'll cool slightly more or warm slightly, so the forecast is for near persistence.

Extended Forecast Discussion: An impressive Gulf of Alaska storm system is forecast to slam the Alaskan Panhandle later this week while high pressure aloft builds over SoCal. A warming trend should begin for the North Bay Thu-27th, but an embedded offshore low may curb the warming initially. However, a massive upper ridge is forecast to build offshore by Sat-29th (once the big storm well to the north departs) and then expand inland across the Pac NW & NorCal Sun/Mon. Meanwhile, the weak embedded offshore low is forecast to move east over AZ. That combination will generate an offshore circulation over the North & Central State that may result in a 2 day hot spell where temps in Napa County could push well into the 90s (maybe locally in the north to near 100F). However, medium range models show a rapid collapse of this big West Coast Ridge by the middle of next week as a deep trough dives down the coast from western Canada, possibly forming into a large cutoff low off the California Coast by the end of the next week. There's a lot going on here (and a lot that could change before it gets here), but we could be looking at couple of hot days next weekend/early next week followed by dramatic cooling in a matter of days ("Hel lo fall!"). Rain at this point appears unlikely, although can't be ruled out by 3rd-8th.
